



Solutions

"Root causes"

Menu of evidence-based solutions to choose from:

- Increased school funding
- Targeted social services
- Jobs for teens
- Strengthened law enforcement

What would serious solutions cost?



Well into the 9 figures

For targeted social services, for instance, assume \$30K / participant, assume reduced violence involvement by 50% Evans & Owens 2007 J Pub E suggests 10% increase in PD budget reduces homicides by 10%

Here's another (related) criminal justice priority that will also require additional resources




More supervisors

More mental health supports


More investigators for citizen complaints

LA shows: *possible* to \u2214 crime while \u2214 police-community ties









What would Chicago's population look like if we had followed New York City's homicide trend?




Fewer residents = fewer taxpayers








